



# CAR IN POLAND

## DOCUMENTS:

- driving license issued in the EU, EFTA countries, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway or Switzerland
- liability insurance

## EQUIPMENT:

- legible license plate
- warning triangle
- working fire extinguisher

## SELECTED TRAFFIC RULES:

1. Cars drive on the right side of the street.



2. Pedestrians must be given priority in the lanes.



3. Cyclists traveling on a bicycle path must be given priority.



4. Driver and passengers must wear seat belts.



5. A child must travel in a child seat.





6. Speed limit applies:

- in built-up areas - 50 km/h
- in undeveloped areas - 90 km/h
- on expressways:
  - single-lane roads - 100 km/h
  - dual carriageways - 120 km/h
- on highways - 140 km/h



7. Use of radar detectors is prohibited.

8. A driver may not use a cell phone while driving.



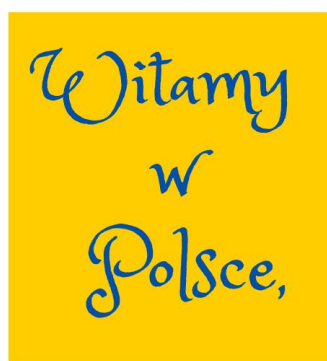
9. It is not allowed to drive a car after drinking alcohol.  
The permissible amount of alcohol in the body:  
0.1 mg/l in exhaled air or 0.2 per mille in blood.



There are paid parking zones in Torun and other Polish cities. Payment can be made at parking meters or through apps, such as Skycash.

Failure to pay for parking = fine.
